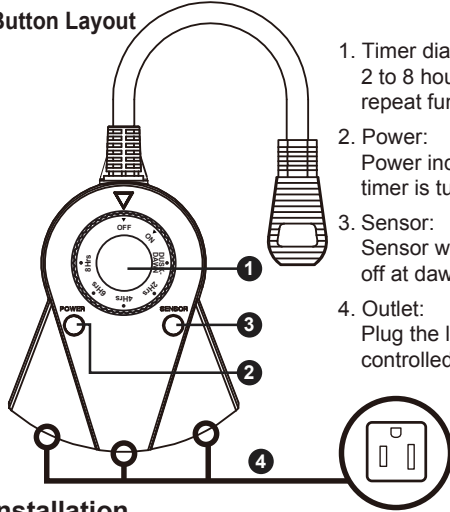


# OUTDOOR MECHANICAL TIMER

**WARNING:** The device must be mounted in a vertical position with the receptacle facing downward and with the receptacle at least 2 ft. above the ground level to prevent water immersion.

## Button Layout



1. Timer dial:  
2 to 8 hours or dusk to dawn and daily repeat function.
2. Power:  
Power indicator light indicates if the timer is turned on or off.
3. Sensor:  
Sensor will turn timer on at dusk and off at dawn.
4. Outlet:  
Plug the lights or devices to be controlled by the timer into outlet.

## Installation

This outdoor mechanical timer has multiple settings from 2 to 8 hours or dusk to dawn and daily repeat function. Full 15 Amp rating will handle lighting and light-duty loads.

## CAUTION

Suitable for use with outdoor appliances. For use ONLY with a three conductor GFCI protected outlet. Do not immerse in water. DO NOT EXCEED RATED CAPACITY.

6 Hrs	On at dusk, stays on 6 hours*
8 Hrs	On at dusk, stays on 8 hours*

\*Cycle repeats every 24 hours
